8th Grade Football Rules and Expectations

The following school rules A-D apply as set forth by the student handbook. Rule E sets guidelines for participation in games.

A. Disciplinary Action:

A student suspended from school attendance (OSS) for disciplinary reasons cannot participate during the suspension period, including practice.

B. Attendance:

Students must attend school the day of practice or a game to be able to participate. A day of attendance means the student must be in class at least one-half of the day. This would mean that the student must be in attendance no later than 11:30AM. Exceptions will be made for pre arranged absences or family emergencies.

C. In School Suspension:

Students placed in In-School Suspension (ISS) for disciplinary or attendance problems will have their playing time determined by the coach. Further discipline problems will result in school discussion regarding eligibility.

D. Physical Education:

Athletes who are medically excused from regular Physical Education classes may not participate in practices or games until they obtain a doctor's release or a release from the School Nurse. Also, any athlete frequently not dressing for PE for any reason may not participate in practices or games.

E. Additional Rules and Expectations:

- a. Every player must participate in at least 10 practices before they can play in their first game.
- b. Players are expected to be at practice on time and prepared.
- c. Players must attend and participate in practices in order to get playing time in a game.
- d. Players missing practice during the week will have their playing time adjusted.
- e. Players missing practice or not participating the day before a game will not play in that game. The exception to this rule is excused absence due to illness the day before a game. The player will be able to participate in the game but will not be able to start in that game.
- f. If a player has been injured and missed practice (s) they must participate in contact during a practice before they can participate in a game.
- g. If a player is not prepared for a game (i.e. missing equipment, uniform, etc.) the player will not play unless parents are able to bring the equipment to school before the bus leaves.
